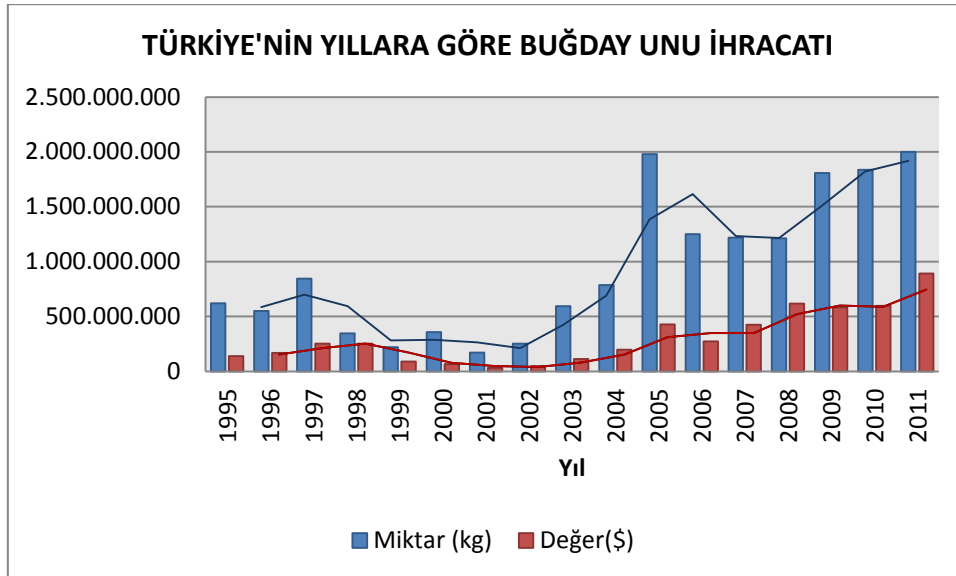

## TURKISH FLOUR EXPORT 2011

The goal of our flour industrialists, who reach the peak of world flour trade and TFIF is to continue the flour exports more than 100 country, to create new markets, to keep the sustainability of Turkish Flour brand and continue corporation for the development of agriculture and sharing knowledge between cultures and international corporations.

The flour export of Türkiye has been accelerated in recent years. Also, the agriculture sector has gained this advantage, too. Our sector has been in a situation that they can compete with leader countries since the institutional capacity of Turkish flour millers brought together under the same roof of TFIF. At the beginning Türkiye was after Kazakhstan and the EU due to technologic and logistic problems; but now, Türkiye is able to compete with both the EU and Kazakhstan.

Furthermore, according to the statistics of the end of the year 2011, Türkiye is the leader of both technology and flour quality. We believe that Turkish flour breaks through being a brand. Türkiye has had a well export potential and has become either the first or the second among other exporter countries in the world. Despite the severe circumstances, Türkiye kept the leadership owing to the efforts of Turkish flour millers to adapt themselves to the altered circumstances, in the year 2010.

TFIF worked hard, too in order to create institutional scale policy and in order to follow the markets both inside the country and the world.

We declared our leadership of the year 2011 according to the statistics of the month September, in November 2011. Although the January – September term cumulative flour export of Kazakhstan was 1,137 M/T, Türkiye exported 1,493 M/T of flour in the same period of time. Total amount of our flour export in the year 2011 is 2.001.095 kg; the value of this amount is 892,494 dollars. The data about Kazakhstan's exports are not declared yet; however, we expect that the amount would be between 1,525–1,600 M/T.

Besides the high amount of flour that we export, the value increased sharply and reached almost 900 million dollars. In 2005, it was 425 million dollars so the disposal value is more than two times higher than the one in 2005. This situation reveals that how much our exporter's ability of marketing and selectivity has been improved.

If we look through the percentage distribution of our export in terms of the regions, we see that the Middle East Countries are the first with 46.83%, and then South East Asia with 27.70% and the third is Africa with 22.32%. Our export to Africa was decreased around 10% in 2010 and this year it is increased. The main reason behind this development is that after the Arabic spring the production capacity of some countries are decreased as we mentioned in the earlier reports.

If we have a look at the countries among the regions, the important markets are Iraq, United Arab Emirates, Israel, Philistine and Saudi Arabia in Middle East, Libya, Tunisia, Sudan, Gambia, Guinea, Maritus, Madagascar, Mozambique, Tanzania, Kenya, Djibouti, Angola and Congo in Africa. The important markets for our export are Indonesia, Philippines, Malaysia, Thailand, South Korea and Singapore in South East Asia. Furthermore, our sector which aims to reach new markets, Haiti in Latin America and Albania in Eastern Europe are very important new markets that w began to sell them Turkish flour.

According to the findings of TFIF research report, we believe that solutions can be generated about entrance to the new markets and its obstacles. For the countries chosen by TFIF as part of the market research, the sector representatives will be informed about the improvements after the appointment of Trade Counselor of Ministry of Economy in the near future.

The debates are in progress with the Ministry of Economy about our export potential in the other regions and turning to the new markets. According to our first impressions, we have the capacity to export to Eastern Europe, Latin America, Middle East, North Asia and Oceania. Moreover, it is possible that we can be more active in Southeast Asia.

Within this scope, to produce new politics and to sustain them and also to give our economy and the next generations a high value added sector, we have to achieve educated labor force so we can reach the 2023 goals.

Within the frame of export performance in the year 2011, the countries who need flour import and the countries in which we're experienced are analyzed in order to develop the present markets and new markets strategy. Although almost all the import of Philippines in South and Southeast Asia is supplied by Türkiye in 2010, it is possible to work for increasing the present capacity on this area. It may be taken into consideration that studying on Turkmenistan and Tajikistan can be a way to begin export to these areas although they are neighbor with Kazakhstan. We do not have market in Haiti, Latin America. It may be important that boards of trade can be sent to this region beginning with Brazil, Bolivia and Cuba for market research.
